THE INSTRUCTIONS



First, look through the different ballot pages and pick the ones that match your family's favorite foods — there's everything from hamburgers and chicken fingers to pizza and nuggets. Once you've picked the right ballots, print enough copies from that page so every family member gets one. Then, cut out the ballots along the dotted lines. Everyone votes by marking their favorite choice, folds their ballot to keep it secret, and drops it in the "ballot box" (even a hat or a bowl will work!). After all the votes are in, count them together and see which dinner wins. Is there a tie? Have a coin toss - just like a real election!
